PROJECT & CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT (PM|CM)

CONSTRUCTABILITY REVIEWS (CR)

A formal third-party review of architect/engineer design drawings and specifications and proposed construction schedules before the project is bid. The CR identifies recommended improvements and later confirms if the recommended improvements were incorporated.
